## Nissan GU Patrol Stainless Snorkel to Factory Airbox Installation Instructions:

## Please cut inside the lines and trim to suit the snorkel.

- 1. Firstly, tape the front passengers guard with masking tape (*this prevents scratches when making the hole*).
- 2. Cut the hole out of the template before placing it and taping it on the guard.

  Use a marker to mark the hole directly on the guard.
- 3. Remove the plastic guard liner from under the guard.
- 4. Remove the steel intake from inside the guard.
- 5. Remove the airbox and then trim the lip off the snorkel end. Leave the 90mm pipe intact. (see image attached).
- 6. Cut the snorkel hole in the guard (We use a 102mm hole saw, cut off disk and flappy disk).
- 7. Use a file to remove any excess steel from around the hole.
- 8. Prime the bare steel with paint.
- Run the provided pinch weld rubber around the hole and trim it accordingly.
- 10. Trim the inner guard where the snorkel comes through. This needs to accommodate the silicon join that will go in there.
- 11. Slide the  $4'' 3.5'' 90^{\circ}$  silicon join from the guard into the engine bay.
- 12. Slide the 420mm piece of stainless into the 4" side of that silicon join. The 3.5" side will connect straight to your airbox.
- 13. Slide the 4" straight silicon joiner onto the other end of the stainless. This will then connect to your snorkel.
- 14. Insert the snorkel into the hole.
- 15. Mount the bracket inside the A-pillar (under the rubber) using the nutserts provided. The nutserts will need 9mm holes.
- 16. Make sure all four of the hose clamps are on the joiners.
- 17. Re-install the plastic guard liner under the guard.
